
Measurement Guide

Shades

<u>Step 1:</u> Mount type – Indicate how the shade will be mounted. Options include:

- Inside Mount (Within window or wall enclosure)
- Outside Mount (extending beyond enclosure)
- Ceiling Mount

<u>Step 2:</u> Height measurement – This measure represents the total height of the shade when fully open.





Tip

Adding a few inches to the height will ensure proper fit.

<u>Step 3a:</u> Inside measurement— This measurement is used to describe the minimum width measured inside an enclosure, such as a window casing, when the shade will be installed inside the enclosure. Most shades are installed in this fashion. If the shade will be placed inside a walled enclosure, provide the same inside measurement for the enclosure. We will make a small deduction to this measurement to accommodate your hardware.

<u>Step 3b:</u> Alternative Outside Measurement— This measurement is used to represent the finished size of a shade regardless of the window size. This is typically provided when the shade will be wall or ceiling mounted outside of an enclosure or for some reason the shade must be a specific size. Provide the actual measurement of the finished shade as it may extend past an enclosure that needs to be covered. No deductions will be made on our part.
